

# Listen to the Voice of Villages

Listen to the Voice of Villages is an european project supported by the European Union and the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF), which unites nine partners from six Central-European countries. The aim is to promote the competitiveness in rural villages in Europe, improving their economic performance and enhancing their natural, cultural and local craft resources. A midterm goal of the project is to create the international association "Vital Villages". Through the association tourists will be able to discover these territories and visit them in a sustainable way.

The project idea was based on the analysis of the content typical for many Central European areas: marginalisation (of a geographical, economic, social and cultural nature), depopulation and demographic changes due to the progressive ageing of the local population, along with the serious lack and inadequacy of an area development policy. For several years rural areas have suffered from major difficulties and problems in terms of competitiveness, attractiveness and unemployment. On the other hand, the areas concerned have enormous natural, cultural and historical assets and a wealth of local crafts. These resources, if properly exploited, could become the real economic driving force for these areas.

The main goal and priority of the project is to increase the competitiveness and attractiveness of these rural marginal areas, which have unexploited touristic potential, through the setting up and implementation of new governance tools. With the drawing up of new pilot projects within the sector of sustainable tourism the project targets on a long-term perspective for the envisaged regions. The most important project activities are based on the drafting of a new scheme for governance of these territories, testing this model through the use of pilot projects and capitalising on the results and output achieved. This capitalisation will be carried out by establishing the "Vital Villages" Association, a transnational organization, and by organizing training activities involving exchange of the best practice.

In this catalogue we would like to present responsible tourism products related to partner's territories in Italy, Slovenia, Austria, Germany, Czech Republic and Poland. Most of them represent also pilot projects like guided tours, workshops, educational trails, "packages" and events

# Vital Village Association

The Vital Village Association has been created by the partners of Listen to the Voice of Villages project in order to guarantee a prosecution of the network established and to give to the pilot areas involved a durable and sustainable structure for their project continuation. Furthermore, marginal area with similar feature of the members and oriented to the same topics, are welcome to join the association. The initial objectives of the VVa are:

- establishing a network in order to concretely promote local and international cooperation;
- developing issues related to local development through tourism in the areas of the project partners and other potential partners;
- becoming a research and monitoring centre with relation to sustainable tourism;
- working in the field of capacity building for private and public management;
- supporting members to increase their project capability to get European funding and to develop a lobbying strategy at national and international level.

The Association will assist with the establishment and development of DMOs (destination management organisations) in the various areas belonging to the project partnership and of any future partners, by providing scientific consultancy managed by University of Trento, eTourism Research Group.

Support from the Association will be directed at the creation of tourist products responding to market demand and the principles of sustainability drawn up by the University of Natural Resources and Applied Life Science (Austria), within the context of the Listen to the Voice of Villages project, with the scope of encouraging local development.

# Voice of World War I

The Tesino plateau and the valley of Vanoi were witnesses to dramatic events during World War I. LA MONTAGNA RACCONTA allows visitors to hike a network of mountain trails on the Lagorai mountain chain, rich with sites of high historical interest, still clearly visible with evidence of an almost forgotten wartime.

With the help of the guidebook "La Montagna Racconta" and the dedicated trails' signs, visitors may follow a path that is not only physical but also emotional. The testimonies and diaries of soldiers at the frontline during wartime, collected in the guidebook, will project the reader into the past when the beauty of these landscapes was overcome by the cruelty of war.

# Along The Herdsmen's Trails In Velika Planina



The Feeling Of Home In Jablaniška Dolina

Under the plateau Velika planina there is valley Kamniška Bistrica, with one of the clearest river in Slovenia. By hike or a cable car you can reach plateau with one of the most well preserved and attractive settlements of herdsmen's huts in Europe. Velika planina is charming every time of the year; especially in summer, when herdsmen drive up the cattle for its summer pasture. This is how Velika planina lives and breathes, preserving its tradition that has been kept for thousands of vears. You can visit the Preskar hut that has been transformed into a museum and a chapel dedicated to our Lady of the Snows. On the Zeleni Rob mountain lodge it is possible to taste alpine cheese (optional warm snack).

Upon return to the valley, we suggest to visit Žganjeteka – liquor tasting shop (the first in Slovenia) that offers more than 150 different types of authentic and homemade liquors from different Slovenian regions. Another point of interest is the spring of river Kamniška Bistrica and the valley's most significant natural sight, the gorges of Mali and Veliki Predaselj.

The captivating charm of Velika Planina lies beyond its specific ethnological and architectural features, as it possesses richness in terms of geology, relief, hydrology, climate, vegetation and history. The area of Velika Planina is Slovenia's largest highland pasture. It is frequently described as the most beautiful Slovenian mountain, offering breathtaking views of the Kamnik- Savinja Alps and the Ljubljana Basin accompanied by a well-preserved herdsmen's heritage. On our trip we will experience unforgettable moments on Velika Planina; together with herdsman in traditional clothing, we will also taste cheese and discover the natural features of Kamniška Bistrica and medieval town Kamnik.

We will begin our tour in the Museum of river transport, coal mining and the railway in Litija. In this unique museum we will learn something about the busy traffic flow that used to prevail on the longest river in Slovenia, the Sava River. A great variety of gravel stones was amassed in a village on the Sava River and is now on display as a geological collection. The stones show the geological structure of this area.

Our next stop will be a tasting of excellent cheese. The

owner will show us the farm and we will be served

home-made cheese and cheese spread, which will

also be for sale. Then a coach will take us to the slopes

of the Jablaniška Valley. The historical importance of

this area derives from the very old churches scattered

around its hills and valleys. On a farm known as the

Farm of Memories (Domačija spominov) we will step

into the past. To stretch our legs and to get some fresh

air, we will later ascend to the mysterious

archaeological site called Roven. At the top we will be

rewarded with an amazing panoramic view. In a nearby

village, organic farmers will offer us delicacies from

the "krušna peč", which is a traditional Slovenian

bread oven typical for farmhouses. We will guench our

thirst with a glass of fine home-made wine. A very

special gift for your family back home would be a freshly

baked "potica", a traditional Slovenian sweet and

home-made bread. After a lively chat on the farm, we

will return to the valley, where numerous culturally

important hay-racks ("kozolci") that are typical for this

country can be seen. We will have a meal in a traditional

Do you fancy a walk on the only wooden pavement

in Slovenia? We will head to a mountain pass where

we will see an example of a very successful business

in the countryside. The host, who has an extraordinary

sense for nature and this area, will take us into the world of wood craftsmanship and gardening. From this spot we will also have a breathtaking view of the Kum Hill or of a sunset over the hills of the Dolenjska region.

# Lords And Charcoal Burners

Travel through a valley of a hundred castles to the geometric centre of Slovenia and from there on to the land of charcoal.

We will begin our discovery of the countryside's beauty in the valley of a hundred castles, the Moravče Valley, in the Tuštanj Castle. This castle has a rich history which reflects in its architectural design. Part of the castle has been turned into a museum which houses some valuable exhibits showing life as it used to be. We will see antique furniture, coffered floors, porcelain, tiled stoves, and much more. The chapel next to the castle is a favourite place for wedding ceremonies today.

We will continue our tour through the Moravče Valley to the Geometric centre of Slovenia. A special monument marks this spot. Just a stone's throw away from there is situated a friendly village, famous especially for an archaeological discovery of the Vače situla. We will learn what exactly a situla is and what it looks like after a 15 minute walk from St. Andrews Church (Cerkvica sv. Andreja).



Our tour will then lead us along Sava and through Jablaniška Valley to the land of charcoal. On our way we will first have a delicious meal, and then we will set off on foot from Dole pri Litiji to the heart of the land of charcoal where we will learn about the life and work of charcoal burners. We will see a large black charcoal kiln and learn how such kilns are built. After seeing the technical heritage of this land our tour will take us through Podkum back home.

The Land of Charcoal is situated on the plateau of Dole in the eastern part of the heart of the Slovenia Region. The area is famous for charcoal burning, mills and sawmills in the valley of Bistrica, and for skiing. In addition to its rich natural and cultural heritage, the plateau is an ideal starting point for trips to the surrounding areas. Charcoal-burning was brought to this area more than one hundred years ago by Italians. Even today, there are twelve charcoal-burning farms that burn up to 30 charcoal piles at 2000 hectares of forest.

# Energy Tourism - The Energy Camp

An energy experience-oriented program in Southern Burgenland Nature Resort 'Weinidylle'

As part of the EU-funded CENTRAL EUROPE program and the project 'Listen to the Voice of Villages', the University of Natural Resources and Life Sciences in Vienna has developed a three-step concept for promoting awareness for the use of renewable energies. This concept (VISIONe -Vital Solar Innovationenergy) was developed in collaboration with local players (in tourism, regional development, politics, private businesses and education) of the Güssing region (Burgenland), and is based on current developments in the area.

# Renewable Energies are fun and leave room for creativity and exploration!

By developing new tourist programs with a fun, dynamic and experience-based approach to the very recent topic of renewable energies, a new niche in the tourism sector is created: "experience-oriented energy tourism". It integrates itself into the region's long-standing experience and pioneering efforts in implementing renewable sources of energy. The overall emphasis is placed on children and adolescents, but additional attractive programs are planned for adults and families as well. A core issue of the VISIONe concept is the Energy-Camp, a test phase of which was launched successfully on the market in 2011 for the first time. The Energy-Camp can be a first step towards a conscious and long-term efficient way for our society to use energy.

# Thematic Path: Route of Half-Timbered Houses

The Route of Half-Timbered Houses enables hikers and bikers to get in touch with local heritage and traditions by guiding along several half-timbered houses in Upper Franconia. The three routes on offer guide through Europe's biggest sweet cherry growing area, past impressive rock formations and by a great number of typical Franconian small restaurants. The guide was developed as a brochure and it does not only list over 30 half-timbered houses of which every single house has its own history, but it also offers these historic developments and circumstances of every single building on site to the reader. Due to practical limitations, the guide can't show every single example of this very special Franconian art of construction in the area, but it enables you to learn a lot about the subject and possibly you can find your very own half-timbered jewel when tracing the paths.

# Three paths are provided by the route:

- The northern trail is guiding around the beautiful "Walberla" hill with a length of about 22 km. It is perfect for hiking and biking. There are seven villages connected on this trail, each with two halftimbered houses.
- The southern trail is about 40 km long and is directed to bikers. On this tour, two houses in each of the nine villages are presented in the booklet.
- The third path is connecting the northern and southern trail (length: 20 km) and provides the possibility to cross the route from one railwaystation in the north to one railway station in the south. Along the trail, 16 houses in eight villages are presented in the brochure.

The Route was created in cooperation with the local transport association VGN. This fact guarantees that getting to the Route, discovering the paths and getting back home is organized in a sustainable and ecofriendly way of transportation and travelling.

The area of Franconian Switzerland now offers a new attraction for people who want to discover this area in all its variety and beauty: supporting local fruit farmers with their daily work of harvesting, processing, distilling or marketing of fruits on their farms. In return for that support you may enjoy free board and lodging, you will make a unique vacation experience and are able to get in touch with the life of a fruit farmer in rural Franconian Switzerland.

Especially for those who live in bigger cities and who are not familiar with the life in rural areas characterized by agriculture and agricultural products, taking part in the pilot project provides an all new way of tourism and spending their holidays. But this offer also provides a lot of new experiences for those who already were in contact with rural areas: the scenic landscape formed by the geologic formation of the Franconian cuesta, the diverse cultural tradition and the historic heritage of Upper Franconia. You will get to all these impressions together with the fruit farmer and his or her family, therefore you will also learn a lot about real life in the area at first hand and how a fruit farmer is working and living.

Living on a farm with the fruit farmer is a very sustainable and environmentally friendly way of tourism. Besides that, you will also do a very reasonable work by helping the fruit farmer and you will be getting to know about the agricultural, economical and technical side of things that concern today's fruit farmers.

You are invited to enjoy the nearby recreation by ample spaces of unspoilt nature and many cultural events. The region is characterised by the unique landscape of Franconian Switzerland: The "lowlands" with their valleys along the rivers Regnitz, Wiesent and Aisch as well as the "uplands" of Franconian Switzerland provide ideal possibilities for leisure, sports and tourism. Europe's largest coherent sweet cherrygrowing area, for example, is in the district of Forchheim. # Traces of Mines Ústí Region

Traces of Mines – the product takes the visitor into the areas affected by mining activities in the past; coal is still extracted and energy produced in some of them.

Two study routes are targeted towards educational and experience tourism. Excursions and visits to the selected locations affected by mining show the visitor the mining history and the current status of the area as well as the realized processes of reclamation, recultivation and revitalisation. The study paths cross 32 municipalities where the places of interest are depicted with the area's mining activity and natural heritage taken in mind. The visitor may choose to cover the entire trail or to visit only the part that interests him. The natural sites are available throughout the whole year, although some restrictions might arise due to the weather. Visits to the open pits must be arranged in advance because they are limited by the number of persons and weather conditions are important.

# The visitor chooses the places of interest and the days of stay

Two study routes are included in the package, TUŠIMICE study route and BÍLINA study route. Both routes involve visits to the museums, excursions to the mines, sightseeing of the recultivated areas and natural sites, a visit to the eco-farm, and an interactive excursion in the Ledvice power plant together with a 3D film production. The visitor can also take advantage of sightseeing flights, and the route may be covered on bicycle or on foot along hiking paths.

All the points of interest are located in the districts of Chomutov, Most, Teplice and Ústí nad Labem. The area is located at the foot of the Ore Mountains in the territory of the North Bohemian Coal Basin. The longterm intensive and predominantly surface extraction in the open pits represents a basic territorial and landscape phenomena that completely changed the character of the landscape. The entire area of the mines in the districts of Chomutov and Teplice overlaps 20%, and more than 30% of the total area in the district of Most. The extent of the surface mines in respective districts represents 6% and 7% of the total area.

# Geocaching in Bohemian Switzerland

Geocaching is a real-world outdoor treasure hunting game. Players try to locate hidden containers, called geocaches, using GPS-enabled devices or smatrphones and then share their experiences online. Geocaching in Bohemian Switzerland is based on locating geocaches related to small sacral monuments hidden in the landscape of National Park.

Geocaches contain information about the respective object, project and region and have been placed in the proximity of some selected repaired monuments. The project is linked with the NGO Bohemian Switzerland website, where are also gathered all available information about the monuments.

We are also planning a related service - the purchase and rental of GPS locators for visitors to the region. In our information centers, where we also operate an internet café, tourists will be able to plan a hiking route with geocaches and rent a GPS device necessary to find them.

We believe that this service will attract new visitors to the region and provide them with new experiences. The product is intended particularly for young people and families with children.
